Hi Tyler,

The over 5,400 workforce mobility and relocation professionals who are members of Worldwide ERC® strongly support the February 24 Presidential Proclamation revoking Proclamation 10014. The revocation of Proclamation 10014 will enable employers to continue to attract some of the best foreign talent to fill U.S. skills gaps and help in economic recovery and growth. We thank the President for his early action on the issue and the Domestic Policy Council for its role in the Proclamation.

We respectfully [request](#) that the President also revoke Proclamation 10052 and allow foreign workers using nonimmigrant visas to enter the United States. Without the revocation of Proclamation 10052 in its entirety, U.S. employers will still be denied access to foreign talent for key positions as we focus on our economic recovery from the COVID-19 public health emergency.

The relocation of employees across borders is critical to the operations of businesses as [we prioritize a safe return to business](#) as well as the growth of the U.S. and global economies. Many employers intend to resume those moves critical to their business as soon as possible as countries and regions around the world begin to slowly recover from the COVID-19 pandemic. It is vital that the U.S. institute policies that facilitate the access and safe reopening to foreign talent for U.S. employers to remain competitive in the global economy.
